Balrothery Community Council has identified and prioritized many of the issues concerning residents of Balrothery. We have been petitioning, attending Deputation meetings and meeting our local representatives to seek resolution to the issues. Listed below are many of the main issues several of which have been budgeted for in Fingal County Council 2008 Plan. To date no action has been taken and no work begun.

We are very dissatisfied with the inaction by Fingal County Council and our local representatives; we would appreciate a direct response on each issue outlined below.

- 1. New Pedestrian Crossing to be installed at Inch Rd to facilitate access to Rugby and Cricket Clubs**
- 2. Major modification to junction at main rd at Balrothery Inn, to reduce traffic congestion at peak times facilitating vehicles turn left and right simultaneously.**
- 3. Resurfacing of roads: to Man O War, Skerries etc.**
- 4. Repair, restructure and parking prevention of several footpaths throughout village.**
- 5. Development of path to Heritage centre (Old Church)**
- 6. Provision Of footpath to tennis courts.**
- 7. Speeding: The 50K zone to be extended. Traffic calming measures required, Major and minor roads through village.**
- 8. Line Painting and warning signage at junction to Skerries/Man O War.**
- 9. Pedestrian linkage between Balruddery Wood/Field to Playing Fields, tennis courts and a path to Community centre/Village proposed.**
- 10. Major Drainage works around tennis courts playing fields and restore and repair boundaries.**
- 11. Rose Park: Planning Dept confirmed that a submission has been received from the developer regarding open space and that the Holly Well is going to be restored and retained. Currently with Duchas for approval.**
- 12. Parks Division have identified 6 proposed locations for playgrounds in the area and details are to be forwarded to Community Council.**
- 13. Unfinished development: Planning provisions being enforced. Severely dangerous banks onto main road at Balrothery wood/field.**
