Once again the junction at Knightswood has been the scene of a serious traffic accident (pictures attached) , thankfully nobody was fatally injured this time. This Junction is a lethal spot and we demand urgent attention to prevent further serious accidents and before someone is fatally injured. The problems are detailed below.

- 1) The rules of a roundabout are ignored.
- 2) Traffic is consistently Speeding.
- 3) When crossing from Village side to Knightswood it is impossible to observe traffic from both directions.
- 4) On Knightswood side the path is not dished and there is no entry point only a grass verge.
- 5) Cars are always parked completely on opposite path so this is not an option for pedestrians.

This matter has been on the agenda for several years now and has been highlighted at Community Council Delegation meetings every time. This needs urgent attention and your assistance is requested.
