Dear All,

Thank you for your attendance at our recent Deputation review meeting, once again we and the residents of Balrothery are very grateful for your support.

We have been established nearly two years now and are very pleased with progress. I have attached the minutes of the meeting; also for those who were unable to attend your support and follow up on the relevant issues would be most appreciated.

A significant budget has been allocated in 2008 for several projects around Balrothery, we are very keen to see these come to completion and we seek your support in moving these forward. Particularly the paths to tennis court and pedestrian crossing to cricket club.

The path from Balrothery Field/Wood to playing field/tennis courts is most welcome and though not currently included an extension to this through council land from playing fields to resource center would be of huge benefit to the community, opening up of all walkways including school lane from Ringfort to shops and amenities would improve greatly the quality of village life not to mention a more healthy non polluting means of moving around village.

The extension of speed the zone is urgently required, warning signs and traffic calming are urgently required, particularly the junction from village to Man O War and Skerries, resident of Balruddery Wood/Village have no safe place to cross here, lives are at risk at this junction.

In relation to the school crises we will hold a meeting in September and bring all concerned party together to urgently get this issue and seek a suitable solution to the benefit of the community.

We appreciate the pressure being applied to developers to complete housing estates and hope this continues.

On the Holy Well, we are very concerned that neither the Community Council nor the Heritage council are being properly updated on progress and plans for this national monument and would appreciate being better informed of progress.

Once again thank you for your attendance and support, I will follow up with all concerned individually over the coming months.
