In December 2007 I wrote to Michael Lynch asking for the footpath serving the Heritage Centre and graveyard at Balrothery to be repaired. This was subsequently passed to your predecessor Mr David Fennell for action.

So far nothing has been done to improve this footpath and, following the recent heavy rain, it has deteriorated even more. This is potentially a very dangerous situation, particularly in the dark, as many pedestrians use this going to and from the Heritage Centre. I would ask if remedial works to the footpath could be carried out as soon as possible.

Balrothery Community Council have also asked if the following can be provided –

- a path to the tennis courts;
- a path from Balruddery Woods to the playing fields; and
- a path from the Community Centre to the playing fields.
