



**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS 1993 – 2015
PUBLIC TRANSPORT REGULATION ACT, 2009
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES**

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared a Scheme for the provision of a one-way traffic system and traffic improvement scheme at the following location:

- **Balrothery, Co. Dublin.**

The scheme includes a proposed one-way system, zebra crossing and parking bays in Balrothery Village, and traffic calming cushions and anti-skid surfacing on Darcystown Road, with appropriate road signage and line markings where necessary.
